### Life Legacy

Alvin "Al" Curtis Dorman, 83, of Carson City, died March 4, 2016 of natural causes. Al was born Sept 23, 1923 in Yale Oklahoma to Harvey and Bertha Dorman. At a young age Al and his family moved to Tonakwa, Oklahoma where he was raised and spent most of his childhood. In his late teens Al moved to Idaho, and in 1951 he joined the Idaho Army National Guard. He spent 4 years active duty serving in the Korean War, and an additional 2 years stationed in Germany.
