



Jackie 'Jack' Rayford Sandifer

August 29, 1946 - July 31, 2014

Jackie “Jack” Rayford Sandifer, 67, passed away July 31, 2014, surrounded by family at his home in Carson City, Nevada after succumbing to bladder cancer.

He was born on August 29, 1946 in Eunice, Louisiana to Delmar and Lura Sandifer. Jack resided in many locations before moving to Central Heights, Texas where he graduated from Central Heights High School in 1965. As a young man, he held various jobs that ranged from hunting game for others, working as a ranch hand, laying pipe, and working on drilling rigs in the Gulf of Mexico. Most of his adult life was spent working as a salesman for Elliott Electrical Supply.

Jack returned to college at the age of 46 and obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Social Work from Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas in December 1994. Upon graduation he was hired by the Texas Department of Adult Parole and Probation where he worked in Angelina County for six years before moving to Nevada to be closer to his grandsons. Jack retired from the Nevada Division of Child and Family Services in March of 2013.

Survivors include his wife of more than 19 years, Sherry Greig Sandifer; his daughter and son-in-law, Anji and Mark Winebarger of Dayton, Nevada; grandsons, Davis, Hayden, and Colin Winebarger of Dayton, Nevada; sister, Jo Nell Samford of Whitehouse, Texas; sister and brother-in-law, Sandy and Rex McEntire of Lufkin, Texas; sister and brother-in-law, Sandie and Bruce
