As a highly intelligent man John held off on the typical neighbor type gabbing but get him on a subject he enjoyed and he could teach you more in an hour than you could ever learn by researching alone. That's also when the humor would come through and his eyes would sparkle behind that smile!

He was a giving man who helped out his neighbors any time they needed him whether it was the loan of a long ladder or even of a bit of cash to get someone through a tough time. As an animal lover, he was sympathetic and gave aid to the little birds who fell out of the nest under our eaves and over the years as each of our large dogs passed away he drove his tractor across the street to our house and dug their graves for us. He never left without a hug and an "I'm sorry" for Brad and I.

Thank goodness he was also a very forgiving man as I would find out one day about 12 years ago. Within minutes our street was lined with SWAT and Sheriff cars! They parked along the street and in front of John's house and as John, oblivious to what was going on, got into the truck he was

working on to test drive it and they swarmed him with guns drawn! I was yelling at them "NO!" "Not him!" "He's the one that needs protecting!" They put poor John through the embarrassment of exiting the vehicle and questioning right in front of God and everyone on the street. I was saying loudly "I'm so sorry John, I thought I heard gun shots" and While he was leaning over his truck he turned his head and said, "It's OK Zina, it's just a misunderstanding"

It turned out that the truck he was test driving had backfired very loudly quite a few times before they figured out the firing order for the plugs. I baked them some cookies and got an "I'm sorry card" but when I delivered them he just laughed ❤️

The earthly illnesses took their toll on the once vibrant man and although we will always feel his absence here, Mr. John Carl Erb has gotten his dignity back and is finally able to just enjoy his newest life in his forever home with God. Peace be with Sandy and the family and friends of this special guy and know that his love floats to you on the Nevada breezes whenever you remember his dazzling smile 😊
