



Joyce Elaine Briscoe

July 3, 1921 - May 11, 2012

Joyce E. Briscoe, of Carson City, Nevada passed away at the Carson Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on May 11, 2012 after a long illness. She was born to Darwin T. Miller and Alice Miller on July 3, 1921 in Gilbert, Minnesota. Joyce served honorably as a member of the Women's Army Corps (WAC) during World War II, and she was a member of the Aptos, California Chapter of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW). She was proud of her sobriety of 35 plus years, and as a longtime member of Alcoholic Anonymous, AA, she coached many who struggled with their addictions.

Joyce was an entrepreneur and was self-employed in the clothing business for much of her life. (She often referred to it as "the rag business.") In the 1980s, she owned a small record and 8-track tape shop in The Red Barn on Highway 1, near San Juan Bautista, California. Later she moved to Carson City, Nevada and continued to sell antiques and collectibles through the 1990s.

Joyce is survived by her son, Robert M. Franks and his partner, Paul A. Fahey, who reside in Nipomo, California. She has a daughter, Carmen Scott, and a son, Paul Picotte, both of McAlester, Oklahoma; and in Northern California, a brother and sister-in-law, Owen and Leticia Miller, and a sister and brother-in-law, Alice and Bill Tiffin. Joyce has four great grandchildren, grandchildren, and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

Joyce will be remembered as an independent, smart and savvy businesswoman, and, in later years, by her winning smile and helpful nature that drew many people to her.
