Myra Dee Griffith, 77, of Miles City, died peacefully in her sleep at the home of her daughter on October 1, 2011.

Myra was born in Belle Fourche, South Dakota on March 22, 1934 to Marion and Elizabeth (Beilage) Butts. She attended schools and graduated from Powder River High School in 1952.
