In the late 1970s Vaughn led a team of American craftsmen teaching locals in Iran to build homes using earthquake-resistant, western standards. After returning to the States, he formed Williams & Son Builders with son Jeff, and they built many beautiful custom homes in the Lake Tahoe area.
