Vivian Eileen Kuhn was a great listener, a sharp bookkeeper, an avid reader, an enthusiastic dancer, a giving friend, and a loving mother. She passed away peacefully on Friday, May 31, 2013. She was 67 years old.

She was born to Adee and Novella Huggins on Dec. 21, 1945 in Long Beach, CA. She grew up in Torrance, CA. As a child, she often played baseball with her next-door neighbor John Kuhn, a boy who would one day become her husband. One of her most cherished memories was touring Israel and the Eastern Mediterranean during her time at Northwest College.
